

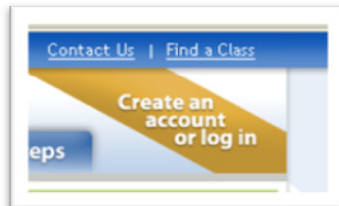
Quick Tips for Getting Started on the Perspectives Website

GO TO WWW.PERSPECTIVES.ORG

1. If you have a Perspectives.org user account

> Log in with your username and password (many places to do this)

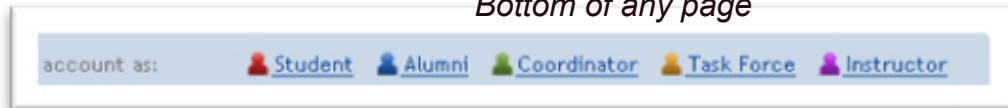
Top right of national website



On the class website



Bottom of any page



> You know you are logged in when it says at the top of the page, 'Welcome back, [your name]

2. If you have never registered and don't have an account

> Go to your class website - find it by state, then click on your local class name

> To Register, click the orange button "Register for this class now"

> Find local class information using the links on the left of the page

> If you just need the 1st or 2nd weeks readings and don't yet have a book,

anyone can go to www.perspectives.org/students even if you don't have an account.

3. If you've registered for First Night Free, and want to complete your registration (you've paid in class or want to pay online)

> Go to your class website

> Click on the "Register Now" link or the orange button

> Fill out the registration form, and use your existing username and password. If forgotten check your email or at least just use the same information, so it won't create a duplicate record.

> If already paid, check the box "Already paid" or you can pay by credit card or e-check if you haven't yet paid.

4. For student resources

Files to download, audio of lessons, discussion board, quizzes, etc.

> Log in at your class website

> Click on Student Resources

5. Edit your personal info

> Go to "My Info" tab

6. Set that website as your class

> Click the 'Set as My Class' button at the top right of your class' home page

> Next time you want to find your class on the same computer, just click on the 'My Class' tab, and it will take you directly to the class you have set as your class.
